What is Preptember really all about?

September is recognized each year as National Preparedness Month, otherwise known as Preptember. This month reminds us that we must prepare ourselves now and throughout the year, and encourages Americans to prepare for a range of emergencies within their homes, business, schools, and greater communities.

What is a bug-out-kit?

A bug-out-kit is a portable apparatus that contains the items necessary to survive for 72 hours when evacuating from a disaster. The purpose of the kit is to allow individuals to evacuate quickly if a disaster should strike. During an emergency situation when you are forced to act quickly, you may not have time to put together an all-inclusive evacuation bag. Making one in advance ensures you are prepared for any emergency. The kit's supplies may vary by individual depending on their specific needs and location, but in general should include: non-perishable food, water, first-aid supplies, blankets, and a flashlight, among others.

Bug-out-kit checklist:

WATER: at least 1 gallon per

person per day

FOOD: non-perishable, ready to

eat, high energy foods

CLOTHING: extra clothing

suitable for your climate

SHELTER: sleeping bag, maybe a

tent, and blankets

ELECTRONICS: a flashlight and

batteries are essential

FIRE SOURCE: matches, lighters

CASH: enough for 72 hours, accounting for an emergency

situation

FIRST-AID: a basic first aid kit
